Banks County High School Local Scholarships 2020-2021

There are varieties of scholarships that only require students to complete the local scholarship application to be considered for eligibility. Other scholarships do require a separate application and those are listed on the school website and the Senior Google Classroom. Those students that complete the local scholarship application will be considered for the scholarships listed below, as well as any additional scholarships in which the donors choose to use the local scholarship application.

- 1. Banks County Board of Education Scholarship
 - a. A graduating Banks County High School student with a parent/guardian that is a current employee of the Banks County School System
- 2. Banks County Chamber CVB STAR Student Scholarship
 - a. Be named the Banks County High School STAR Student
 - b. The STAR student must score the highest on one test date (scores may not be combined from two test dates) on the College Board Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) among the top 10 percent of the class
- 3. Banks County Chamber CVB Open Scholarship
 - a. A Banks County High School graduating senior who will be attending any college after high school graduation
- 4. Banks County Chamber CVB Lydia McClure Technical Scholarship
 - a. A Banks County High School graduating senior who will be attending a technical college after high school graduation
- 5. Banks County Chamber CVB Ambassador Scholarship
 - A Banks County High School graduating senior who is a Student Ambassador with the Banks County Chamber CVB and will be attending any college after high school graduation
- 6. Brother Jim McLendon Scholarship Sponsored by Banks County Rotary Club
 - a. Must be a graduating senior who resides in Banks County
 - Intends to continue education at a 4-year college or university, pursuing a career in ministry, religious education, or related fields such as social work, counseling/therapy, charity work, youth leader, or special education
- 7. Class of '95 Scholarship in memory of Shawn Smith
 - a. A Banks County High School graduating senior that is an athlete with a 3.0 GPA or better
- 8. Vasco & Reba Parker Memorial Scholarship
 - a. A graduating senior at Banks County High School
- 9. Suzanne Stover Memorial PAGE Scholarship
 - a. A graduating Banks County High School senior that plans to attend a post-secondary institution, majoring in education
- 10. Forward Scholarship
 - a. A graduating senior at Banks County High School
 - b. First generation college or technical program student
